EDITORIAL

Why this works

- **Personality:** Nico Panagio. Existing audience. Family-friendly. Bilingual.
- **Stakes:** learning to fly is real, time-bound, visible. There is a genuine licence at the end.
- **Locations:** Okavango Delta, Kalahari, Lowveld, Mozambique coast, Karoo, Limpopo conservancies.
- **Production:** Voetspore. Cape-to-Czech expedition production pedigree.
- **Distribution-friendly:** 8 × 45-min episodes, plus a 90-min cinematic feature cut.
